LEARNING OBJECTIVES

applicable knowledge

The overall goal is for participants to learn things that are as directly applicable in their own daily reality as possible.

eg

- Identify a range of factors that can prevent or allow access to testing and or treatment.
- Be able to describe methods for identifying liver status, and what this means for future action planning.



CERTIFICATION/EXAMINATION

A questionnaire of 10 questions (preferable questions of application) at the end of each of the seven parts...

...unlocks the next part if most of the questions are correctly answered.

The last questionnaire provides access to a diploma and to an application for the *User Academy*.



THE SEVEN PARTS

1. THE LIVER - HOW IT WORKS AND HEPATITIS / JAUNDICE

- An overview of liver anatomy and function.
- A cursory review of the different hep viruses, what characterizes them, their different approach to the liver and their different transmission routes.

2. HEPATITIS C - INFECTION PROCESS

- A review of hep c virus different genotypes and how they attack the liver.
- Explanation of the development of the inflammation from acute to chronic.



cont THE SEVEN PARTS

3. PREVENTION

- Explanation of the main ways by which HCV is transmitted
- A summerise of the main HCV prevention messages.
- An overview of the main interventions that can prevent HCV transmission.

4. TESTING

- An overall guidance of procedures and approaches for testing
- A guidance on what should be done after the very first positive test result.
- A review of the follow-up of positive test results that do not require immediate action.

cont THE SEVEN PARTS

5. LIVER STATUS

- A review of an inflamed liver, showing different status levels and which actions these different status requires.
- Guidance on the different options available to determine the degree of liver damage.

6. GETTING RID OF VIRUS & CURE OF THE INFLAMED LIVER

- An overview of the various treatment options available today, for the different genotypes.
- An overview of the new treatment options that will reach the market in the coming years.
- An overview of the treatment options available for various degrees of liver damage.



cont THE SEVEN PARTS

7. LAWS, RULES AND CONDITIONS

- An overview of the laws, rules and conditions for referral and treatment of people who use drugs (PWID).
- A guidance on what approaches that are advocated by international control means, such as WHO, regarding conditions of treatment for PWID.
