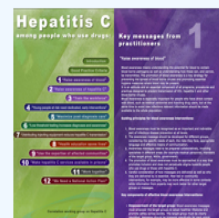
Correlation Network launches 12 key messages for a good Hepatitis C policy and practice among people who use drugs.

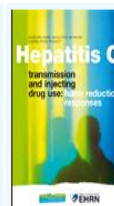


Correlation published a booklet on Hepatitis C: "transmission and injecting drug use: harm reduction responses".
